MINISTER MHAGAMA TO OFFICIATE 5TH LEADERSHIP GRADUATION CEREMONY

13 May, 2022: The leadership graduation ceremony, organised by UONGOZI Institute and Aalto University Executive Education of Finland, will take place today at the Mlimani City Conference Centre, Dar es Salaam. The event will be officiated by the Minister of State, President's Office – Public Service Management and Good Governance (PO-PSMGG), Hon. Jenista Mhagama (MP).

The ceremony is organised under two long-term executive programmes: Postgraduate Diploma in Leadership (PGD) and Certificate in Leadership (CiL). It will see 41 leaders being awarded their diplomas and 76 emerging leaders and executives being awarded their certificates. Leaders from all sectors alongside 35 participants from the sixth cohort of the postgraduate will be in attendance.

"We launched the postgraduate in 2017, and certificate programme in 2020, as part of our commitment to support African leaders to attain sustainable development for their nations and the continent. Both programmes aim to develop leadership competencies in three areas; Making strategic choices, leading people and other resources and excelling in personal leadership qualities," says Kadari Singo, CEO of UONGOZI Institute.

PGD is a year-long programme with a total of 10 modules. Each module runs for one month, consisting of 2-3 days in-class workshops as well as individual and group assignments. CiL includes three modules that are delivered exclusively online over the course of six months. The two programmes motivate participants to become reflective leaders who can embrace agility for more sustainable results. They are designed for leaders who want to propel their professional development without putting their careers on hold.
